B. REGION BAND CLINIC/CONCERT

- 7. <u>Duties of Duties of directors at clinic/concert: cut and pasted from Region 14</u>
 ATSSB Handbook
- 1. If a director has knowledge that a student will not be able to participate in the Region Band or at Area auditions, he/she must contact the Region Coordinator at the earliest possible time.
- 2. Every effort will be made to make directors aware of replacements as soon as possible.

- 3. The region coordinator and band organizer will seat alternates. Directors and clinicians will not make those decisions.
- 4. Each student's director (or a qualified proxy) MUST be in attendance at the rehearsals to assist the clinicians and assist in supervising his/her students.

C. Area Contest

- 1. Area fees are paid by the Region: Site is Orange Grove HS and date is 1/12/2019
- 2. Be aware of holding room guidelines at Area: (http://www.atssb.org/execsec/HoldingRoomGuidelines.pdf)
- 3. Be aware of housing procedures at all-state (Hyatt Regency) and that students must bring a wire stand to state.
- 4. Note that at All-State Chair auditions, no electronic devices shall be allowed in the audition room other than tuners and metronomes (no cell phones or mp3 players or iPods if found, these will be taken up until after auditions); however, students may use electronic media in lieu of printed music (a book is still provided on the stand for student use) so long as the media does not conflict with existing rules governing electronic devices as listed above.

D. Rules

5. Judging requirements if entering students. Cut and pasted from Region 14 Handbook

- 1. DIRECTOR/JUDGE RESPONSIBILITIES-AUDITIONS
- 2. All Full time Directors from each school are required to be in attendance to judge at both the HS and JR HIGH tryouts. If a Director is not present, a letter of reprimand can be issued to the Director's principal, superintendent, and board of trustees.
- B. OPS entry deadline (May? see OPS guidelines or March Newsletter OPS Column).
- C. **Reminder:** No pictures may be taken nor any audio or video recordings made in the room(s) where judges' scores are displayed for directors to check.
- D. Please note that the TMEA online entry process includes a 3A and 4A All-State Track (all students in Class 1A and 2A and 3A are automatically in the 3A Track and all students in Class 4A are automatically in the 4A Track unless they submit a Track Selection with their initial entry selecting another track or TMEA 5A or 6A Track). Entry deadlines are standard statewide with penalties for late entries and all are built into the online entry process and may not be changed:
 - 1. All contests deadlines will be 14 days prior to the audition.
 - 2. The late and final online student entry will be 7 days prior to the day of audition.
 - 3. Correction to an existing student entry may be made between 13 and 7 days prior to the audition without penalty, but any student entry added less than 14 days but more than 7 days prior to the contest will result in an additional 100% student late fee.
 - 4. Entries begun less than 14 but more than 7 days prior to the contest will be assessed a 100% student fee charge.
 - 5. A CAMPUS entry created less than 14 days prior to the contest will be subject to the TMEA Grievance Process.

 - d. Judge 3 can be any person that our region deems qualified.

PARENT/STUDENT UIL MARCHING BAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORM

Updated 2018

No student may be required to attend a marching band related practice for more than eight hours outside the academic school day per calendar week (Sunday through Saturday). This provision applies to students in all components of the marching band. **Exception:** For schools that begin instruction prior to the fourth Monday in August the limit of eight hours of rehearsal outside of the academic school day per calendar week shall begin on the Tuesday immediately following Labor Day. Schools under this exception shall be limited to eight hours of rehearsal outside of the academic day per school week (12:01 AM on the first day of school of the calendar week through the end of the school day on the last day of instruction of the school week) until the Tuesday immediately following Labor Day.

On performance days (football games, competitions and other public performances) bands may hold up to one additional hour of warm-up and practice beyond the scheduled warm-up time. Multiple performances on the same day do not allow for additional practice and/or warm-up time.

Examples of Activities Subject to the UIL Marching Band Eight Hour Rule.

- Marching Band Rehearsal (Both Full Band and Components)
- Any Marching Band Group Instructional Activity
- Breaks
- Announcements
- Debriefing and Viewing Marching Band Videos
- Passing Off Marching Band Music
- Marching Band Sectionals (Both Director and Student Led)
- Clinics for The Marching Band or Any of its Components

The Following Activities Are Not Included in the Eight Hour Time Allotment:

- Travel Time to and From Rehearsals and/or Performances
- Rehearsal Set-Up Time
- Pep Rallies, Parades and Other Public Performances
- Instruction and Practice For Music Activities Other Than Marching Band And Its Components

Please see the information below regarding Section 1104 of the UIL *Constitution and Contest Rules* as it pertains to marching bands and copyright compliance.

Section 1104, Copyright Compliance, in relevant part, states the following:

(a) COMPLIANCE: Compliance with current copyright law is required of all participants in UIL music events. Violations are subject to the penalties outlined in Sections 27 and 29.

UIL expects that all participant schools comply with all applicable copyright laws at its events. It is solely a school's responsibility to determine what licenses may be required and to obtain any and all necessary licenses prior to participation in a UIL event. Such licenses may include, but are not limited to, arrangement licenses or synchronization licenses. UIL recommends that a school with questions regarding its particular musical performance and associated licensing requirements contact the school's legal counsel.

For the 2017-2018 school year UIL will not be selling DVDs or any other type of video recordings of region, area, or state marching band competitions. UIL does plan to offer a live stream of the state competition. Details on that broadcast will be posted at http://www.uiltexas.org/music/marching-band/state as they become available. UIL will also allow a single video of a school's marching band performance to be made from a designated location at the contest venue with the stipulation that such a video be used solely for educational purposes. A school may not use the video of their marching band's performance for any commercial purpose, nor may they allow any third party to make any commercial use of the video. A school wishing to make an educational use video of their marching band's performance must sign and submit a UIL form that sets out the terms and conditions for the creation and use of this limited-use marching band video, no later than seven days prior to the school's UIL contest.

2A AREA E PERFORMANCE ORDER 2018

Below is the performance order for the Preliminaries of the 2A Area E Marching Contest on October 27, 2018, at Gregory-Portland High School in Portland. Performance order was determined by a double-blind random draw conducted by the Region Executive Secretaries at the summer TBA Conference. As each Region certifies bands to advance to Area, the list will be adjusted appropriately. The performance schedule for Preliminaries, with times included, will be distributed after all the Region contests are completed.

Historically, there have never been enough 2A bands entered at the Region level to qualify 14 bands to 2A Area E Preliminaries Competition. Therefore, a Finals Competition has never been required. If there are again 13 or fewer bands qualified for the 2A Area E Contest, the Preliminaries will stand as the Finals, and the top three (3) bands will be certified to State.

However, if there are 14 or more 2A bands in the Preliminaries, then as each band checks in at the Contest Site, the Head Director will draw for a performance slot in the Finals Competition. The top seven (7) bands in the Preliminaries will then be scheduled for Finals based on the performance slot drawn and the scheduling information as explained in the Area Instructions.

GENERAL INFORMATION August 10, 2018

Below is general information that should be useful as you prepare for your potential competition in the 2A Area E Marching Contest on October 27, 2018 at Gregory-Portland High School Wildcat Stadium in Portland, Texas. In the event of inclement weather, every effort will be made to complete the Preliminary Round. If necessary, the Preliminaries may be declared the Finals.
