

Mack Bibb retired from public school education following thirteen years as Director of Bands at Coronado High School in Lubbock. Before coming to Coronado he was Director of Bands at Seymour High School. Mr. Bibb has thirty-five years of experience and has taught at every level from beginning band to university band and music education. His bands have consistently earned superior ratings in UIL competition and his students have been successful at both regional and state levels. In addition to his service at Seymour and Coronado, he has served in an interim capacity as the Director of Bands at Wayland Baptist University and at Lubbock Christian University, and has served as the interim Director of Fine Arts for the Lubbock Independent School District. He is currently a consultant for the Sundown Independent School District. Mr. Bibb is in demand as a consultant, clinician, and adjudicator throughout Texas and New Mexico, and is a member of the Texas Music Educators Association, the Texas Music Adjudicators Association, and Phi Beta Mu, an international band directors' association. He was privileged to be one of the directors of the All-Lubbock Band as they participated in the 2012 Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, California, and the Coronado Band was honored to have been chosen as one of five high school bands in the nation to participate in the St. Patrick's Day Parade in Dublin, Ireland, in March of 2014. Mr. Bibb and his wife, Janey, have been married for forty-six years and have three children and seven grandchildren.

Dr. David Robinson is Director of Bands and Assistant Professor of Music at Tarleton State University in Stephenville, Texas. Appointed in 2018, he oversees all aspects of the Tarleton instrumental music program and serves as conductor of the Tarleton Wind Ensemble. Previously, Dr. Robinson has previously served as Director of Bands at McMurry University in Abilene, Texas. He holds the Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Wind Conducting from the University of North Texas, where he served as a teaching fellow in the world-renowned Wind Studies program. He is the conducting student of Eugene Migliaro Corporon and Thomas O'Neal. From 2009 to 2012, Dr. Robinson served as assistant conductor of the Dallas-based Lone Star Wind Orchestra. He also holds the Master of Music in Wind Band Conducting from the University of Missouri and the Bachelor of Music Education degree in Instrumental Music from Arkansas State University. At the University of Missouri, Dr. Robinson was a member of the MTNA national chamber music finalist Contreras Saxophone Quartet. His secondary teaching experience includes positions with bands in the public schools of Arkansas. He is also active as a composer, performer, and author. His saxophone quartet, *Fantasy on St. James*, was commissioned for and premiered by the Marion (AR) High School Saxophone Quartet at the 2005 American School Band Directors Association's national convention. He was a contributing author to Volumes 7, 8, 9, and 11 of the *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band* series and served as recording editor for *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band: Solos with Wind and Accompaniment*. His professional affiliations include memberships in the College Band Directors National Association, the Texas Music Educators Association, and Pi Kappa Lambda National Music Honor Society, as well as honorary memberships in Kappa Kappa Psi and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.
