JARED SPEARS

Dr. Jared Spears is Professor of Music at Arkansas State University in Jonesboro, Arkansas. He was born in Chicago, Illinois, and received the B. S. E. degree in Music Education from Northern Illinois University; the B. M. and M. M. in Percussion and Composition from the Cosmopolitan School of Music; and the D. M. in Composition from Northwestern University. Some of his teachers were Blythe Owen, Alan Stout, and Anthony Donato.

Spears has taught theory, history, composition, percussion, and band on all educational levels from elementary school through college.

The most outstanding of his awards have been the Faricy Award for Creative Music from Northwestern University School of Music, Award of Merit from the Arkansas Chapter of the National Federation of Music Clubs, Outstanding Educators of America (1973 and 1975), International Who's Who in Music and Who's Who in the World of Percussion - U. S. A., Citation of Excellence from the National Band Association, Sigma Alpha Iota National Arts Associate, and several ASCAP Awards. Spears has also received the President's Award for the outstanding faculty member of Arkansas State University, as well as an appointment as a President's Fellow.

To date he has composed over 250 original works for band, choir, orchestra, and chamber ensembles - a majority of which are published by American and European companies. His music has been performed and recorded worldwide, and he has conducted band festivals, camps, and clinics in the United States, Norway, and Canada, and appeared at universities as guest lecturer.
